## **Further Food and General Waste Tips**For Poster 13

Leeds City Council offers advice as to what waste goes in which bin:

**Brown Bin:** Garden waste including leaves, fallen fruit, grass cuttings, weeds, dead flowers, hedge clippings, twigs and branches. **NOT** food waste, plastic bags, soil & turf or even compostible bags.

Green Bin: Aerosols, mixed paper & card, aluminium foil, plastic bags ,food & drink cans, plastic bottles and any plastic containers showing the numbers 1, 2 or 4 in the small triangle, usually found on the base. NOT glass bottles/jars, garden or food waste, shredded paper, polystyrene, nappies, batteries or syringes. Please wash or rinse all containers before placing in bin. Seek advice for local disposal of glass and syringes.

Black Bin: for all waste that can't be composted or go in your green or brown bins. This is taken to the Recycling and Energy Recovering Facility (RERF) where it is incinerated to produce energy that can heat residential or commercial properties.
